



PARKING RULES/COURTESIES

In order to facilitate the safe passage of emergency vehicles, neighborhood vehicles, and ensure the safety of pedestrians in the community, please adhere to the following:

- 1) We understand that there will be occasion when parking on the street is a necessity, but for residential day to day parking, please use your garage and/or driveway.

On street parking is against the CCRs and it is also a safety issue.

- 2) Do not park over any portion of a sidewalk.

Vehicles parked in driveways but extending onto sidewalks block pedestrian traffic (if applicable).

- 3) Do not park on any portion of a lot.

Vehicles parked on lots are a violation of the CCRs and they damage the grass.

- 4) Do not park in front of or have any portion of a vehicle directly across the street from a driveway.

Vehicles parked directly across from a driveway makes it difficult to enter and/or exit the street.

- 5) Do not park on any street where there is less than 15 feet of unobstructed roadway side as measured from the side of the vehicles facing the street.

Vehicles parked directly across from one another restrict the passage emergency vehicles and residential vehicles in our neighborhood.
